

How to utilize a pharmacy to administer BRIXADI

You can now write a prescription and have BRIXADI administered by a select list of contracted pharmacies.*



*Pharmacies contracted to administer BRIXADI include select ACME, ALBERTSONS, OSCO, PAVILIONS, RANDALLS, SAFEWAY, SAV-ON, TOMTHUMB, UNITED, and VONS locations. The full list can be found at brixadifinder.com/pharmacy.

WARNING: RISK OF SERIOUS HARM OR DEATH WITH INTRAVENOUS ADMINISTRATION; BRIXADI RISK EVALUATION AND MITIGATION STRATEGY

- **Serious harm or death could result if administered intravenously. BRIXADI forms a liquid crystalline gel upon contact with body fluids and may cause occlusion, local tissue damage, and thrombo-embolic events, including life-threatening pulmonary emboli, if administered intravenously.**
- **Because of the risk of serious harm or death that could result from intravenous self-administration, BRIXADI is only available through a restricted program called the BRIXADI REMS. Healthcare settings and pharmacies that order and dispense BRIXADI must be certified in this program and comply with the REMS requirements.**

2 Prescribe BRIXADI for the pharmacy to administer



ePrescribe

Send your prescription to Albertsons Specialty Care:

- Include the NPI number of the pharmacy location's fulfillment center. You can find it on the BRIXADI Pharmacy Locator (see step 1 above)
- In the signature or comments section, include "Pharmacist to administer at" followed by the name of the pharmacy location you selected

You can find the information for the administering pharmacy on the BRIXADI Pharmacy Locator (see step 1 above). Fax the completed enrollment form to Albertsons Specialty Care at 877-466-8040.

3 Prescription processing

Albertsons Specialty Care will process the prescription and reach out to you if any additional information or steps are needed.

A dedicated **Specialty Pharmacy Care Coordinator** will be assigned to you and your patient at that time.

4 Appointment scheduling

The Specialty Pharmacy Care Coordinator will contact your patient to schedule an appointment to administer BRIXADI at the chosen pharmacy location. **Inform your patient that in the next 3 days they should receive a call from Albertsons Specialty Care.** During that first call, your patient will be given the option to opt into electronic communications to receive further communications through email and/or text.

5 Administration

At the appointment to administer BRIXADI, a pharmacist who has been trained to administer BRIXADI will administer the injection.

6 Administration confirmation

You will receive a fax confirming that BRIXADI has been administered to your patient (including date and time).

FAQs on utilizing a pharmacy to administer BRIXADI

I haven't heard from Albertsons Specialty Care since I sent them the prescription. What does it mean?

If you do not hear from Albertsons, the prescription adjudication and administration process is on track and there is no further action required on your part. If you want an update, call Albertsons Specialty Care or connect to the Albertsons Provider Portal.

What should I do if my patient has not received a call within 3 days?

Typically, your patient will receive a call from 877-466-8028 or from a phone number with a 208 area code. If your patient has not received a call from Albertsons Specialty Care within 3 days, call 877-466-8028 to follow up on the status of the prescription. You can also track the status using the Albertsons Provider Portal.

When should I call the administering pharmacy location versus Albertsons Specialty Care?

It is not necessary to contact the administering pharmacy. Please direct all questions to Albertsons Specialty Care.

What happens if my patient wants to go to an administering pharmacy location other than the one indicated on the prescription?

Your patient can work with the Specialty Care Coordinator to have their administration appointment scheduled at another contracted pharmacy location.

What if I want the patient to come to the office for their next injection?

Contact Albertsons Specialty Care to have the medication shipped to your office, or send an updated prescription with a request to deliver the shipment to your office in the notes.

Can I send my prescription for pharmacy administration to a specialty pharmacy other than Albertsons?

Most specialty pharmacies in Braeburn's limited distribution network for BRIXADI will ship the prescription to Albertsons if you have indicated you want a pharmacist to administer. Contact the specialty pharmacy to which you sent the prescription for more information.

What happens if Albertsons Specialty Care cannot fill the prescription due to the patient's insurance?

If Albertsons cannot process the prescription, they will contact you to provide information on other specialty pharmacies in Braeburn's limited distribution network for BRIXADI that can process the prescription and ship BRIXADI to the pharmacy administration location.
